The Code of Conduct was created to ensure a warm and supportive space for all who participate and work it the centers and programing. Participants, visitors and staff are to treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.

The following is considered unacceptable conduct and will not be tolerated:

- Profanity, vulgarity, inappropriate or explicit sexual language
- Hate speech (e.g. racial, ethnic, sexist, homophobic or religious slurs)
- Bullying/Harassment of any kind to anyone (other participants, visitors or staff)
- Fighting, physical abuse, challenging others to fight, destroying or damaging personal property
- Destruction of City materials, equipment, furniture and grounds, or tampering with equipment/property
- Participating in, possession of, or sale of alcohol or Federally prohibited drugs
- Smoking/Vaping, of any kind, inside or on City property
- · Activities that infringe on the rights of participants or staff
- Inconsiderate, discourteous or disruptive behavior
- No sales or solicitations
- No circulation of petitions or surveys
- Violation of federal, state, county or city laws and ordinances
- Inappropriate or revealing attire (shirt & shoes are required at all times)
- Failure to maintain personal cleanliness and good hygiene
