Depending on the type of case, the DRC may make a final decision (approval or denial), recommend action to another deciding body (Planning Commission or City Engineer), or determine that more information is needed (deem application incomplete) before an action or recommendation is made.

Applications that may receive final action (approval or denial) by the DRC:

- Architectural & Site Plan Review (projects up to 15,000 square feet)\*\*
- Minor Variances
- Signs (including those upon referral by the Development Services Director)
- Determination of uses not listed in the Zoning Code (upon referral)

Applications that receive advisory (recommendation) review from the DRC:

- Architectural & Site Plan Review (projects over 15,000 square feet)\*\*
- Reche Canyon Site Plan Review (enclosed or habitable structures)
- Conditional use permits
- Major variances
- Signs (which require Planning Commission review)
- Subdivisions (tentative maps)
- Lot line adjustments and lot mergers

*\*\*Exempt: Single-family detached dwelling, including accessory buildings (except for Reche Canyon Specific Plan Area); minor additions/alterations to existing structures which do not change the external appearance nor increase intensification of use*
