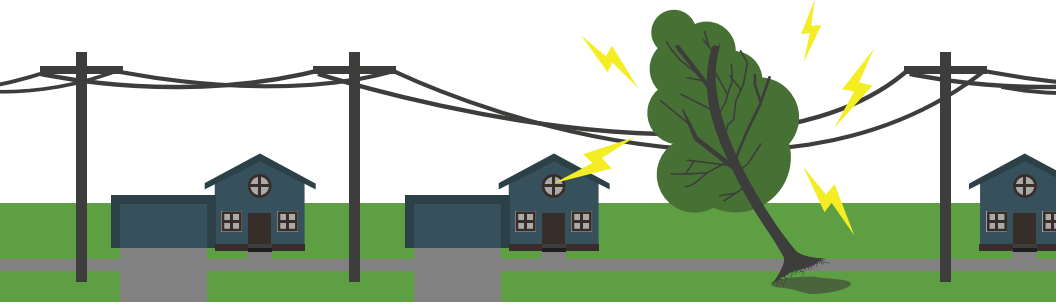


# TREE RELATED EMERGENCIES

## Signs that a tree may be in danger:

- Cracks or splits in large limbs or the trunk
- Hollowing and other signs of decay
- Mushrooms and fungus growing on or near the tree
- Leaning to one side significantly
- Limbs in contact with or in danger of being in contact with power lines
- Branches or portions of a tree over your home
- Dead limbs that stay on trees for too long
- Dead trees are always a danger
- Diseased bark, limbs or roots
- Insect Pests that decline tree health
