

Notice for Neighborhood Meeting

Proposed Project

Where: City of Colton City Council Chambers – 650 N. La Cadena Drive, Colton, CA 92324

Location of Proposed Project: 785 E. M Street, Colton, CA 92324 (Ecology Recycling)

Proposed Project: The proposed project includes the construction of a new 80,640-square-foot prefabricated building to house nonferrous separation equipment (“Material Processing Building”), increase monthly permitted tonnage for the shredder from a permitted capacity of 40,000 tons per month to 55,000 tons per month, and the issuance of an auto dismantling permit/license and processing of end-of-life vehicles for an existing recycling facility. The proposed project is a Modification of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP-D-55-01) and also includes expanding operation to include the use of leased Rail Road property and other off-site improvements of the property including a new entrance at the west side of the project site. Environmental Determination. Changes to the certified EIR and regulatory conditions of the proposed project changes would fulfill none of the conditions outlined in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15162(a)(1) through (3) because these changes would not result in new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects requiring major revisions to the 2006 certified EIR. Accordingly, this checklist provides the substantial evidence required by CEQA Guidelines Section 15164(e) to support the finding that a subsequent EIR is not required and an addendum to the certified EIR is the appropriate environmental document to address changes to the project. Why a Neighborhood Meeting: The purpose of the meeting is to inform the nearby residents of the proposed project, including:

- What is changing from the existing recycling facility
- How the changes will impact the current operations
- Review of Certified Environmental Impact Report Addendum
- The meeting will give residents the opportunity to express any concerns and to ask questions about the proposed project prior to scheduling the project for Planning Commission Agenda.

The applicant will be present to answer questions related to Ecology Recycling. The City of Colton Planning Division staff and the environmental consultant working on behalf of the City will also be present to answer questions about the proposal.
